Parents are most welcome and are encouraged to attend the PSSA games each week if they have the opportunity, to cheer on their children. The PSSA has developed the following code of conduct for parents/ spectators to ensure the children are able to participate to the best of their ability and enjoy the game.

- 1. Encourage participation by your child/ children
- 2. Encourage honest effort and skilled performance.
- 3. Remember that children play sport for THEIR enjoyment.
- 4. Provide a model of good sports behaviour for your child to copy. Applaud good play by all teams.
- 5. Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game.
- 6. Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities.
- 7. Be COURTEOUS in your communication with players, team coach, team officials, game officials and sport administrators and show appreciation for their services.
- 8. Do not interfere with the conduct of any events.
- 9. Respect officials' decisions and teach children to do likewise.
