Council Works

Hawkesbury City Council has provided notification that Odgen Road and Worsley Road are scheduled to be re-sealed, with work commencing within the next few weeks.



We have also been notified that trimming of trees and vegetation near powerlines around the school is scheduled, with work commencing within the next few weeks.

It is hoped that work will commence at the conclusion of the school year. Traffic control will be in operation during the works and traffic congestion is expected, if work commences prior to the end of the school year.

To order, please ring the school and ask to be transferred to the canteen.


