To Order Photos

Today your child was given their individual




photo order form with their own unique shootkey.

To order, you need to go to **www.**msp.com.au, order online, enter your unique shootkey and follow the prompts. If you are missing your shootkey, please call MSP on 02 9831 5505. Please note that there is a section on the top of the page that says 'change shootkey'. This allows you to place orders for all your children in the same transaction.

Family Photos

If you would like a family photo, you can order using the shootkey of your eldest child. Family photos are on a pre-order basis only and will not be taken unless paid for prior to photo day.

Photo Day Information

Class group, individual and family photos will be taken on the day. A photo of your child will be taken regardless of whether you choose to purchase a photo package. The Yr 6 group photo and Councillors will also be taken. Orders for this photo are to be made after the photo day. Further information will follow.

All students must wear **full summer school uniform** for the photos.

Kindergarten students will not be doing sport on the day and must wear **full summer school uniform** for the photos.

If you wish to order a photo but have not paid prior to photo day then a late order fee of \$20 will be charged.

If you are ordering a **family photo**, these will be **taken** before school.

We ask that one parent bring their children to the hall for this photo from 8am and prior to 9am.

Due to Covid 19 restrictions, the parent will need to scan the QR code at the gate and line up at the marked area at the Ogden Road end of the hall. When called, the parent will enter the hall to view the photo. Once complete the parent will leave via the door closest to the carpark and the children will make their way into the playground, via the main door, where they can wait, following the usual morning routine.

Bus Safety Week reminds all road users to 'Be Bus Aware'

Our school bus operator Busways is reminding all road users, parents, and students to 'be bus aware' as part of Transport for NSW's Bus Safety Week campaign, running Feb 22 - 28.



Part of the 'Be Bus Aware' campaign, Bus Safety Week sees Governments, bus operators, and emergency services raise awareness about the importance of being safe in and around buses and spread the message to 'Be Bus Aware'.

Busways Managing Director Byron Rowe said motorists need to be aware that buses are large and heavy vehicles that cannot stop quickly.

"When a bus is forced to brake heavily it can cause passengers to be thrown around inside the bus," he said. "During Bus Safety Week we are educating the community to give buses room and not pull out in front of them. We all have a part to play in bus safety, whether you're a pedestrian, motorist or bus passenger."

Bus Safety Week provides a timely reminder to parents to have a talk with their children about bus safety; to motorists when giving way to buses; to pedestrians to make sure they are alert of their surroundings; and to cyclists to ensure they can see where buses are.

The 'Be Bus Aware' campaign has been developed with input from Bus NSW, NSW Police and Transport for NSW.

- Each student will have a family shoot key included at the bottom of their individual Order form. The family section only needs to be filled out if you wish to order family photos.
- If you do wish to order family photos, please fill out the form of the **ELDEST** student only.
- All orders are to be made **online**.
- Online Ordering Logon to <u>www.msp.com.au</u> and click 'ORDER ONLINE'. Place your order using the online system. Record your Order Reference number on your student's Order form. The student must present their own Photo Order form to their photographer. Click 'CHANGE SHOOT' to place multiple orders in one transaction.
- Credit Card payments Will only be accepted for online orders, or a \$5.00 administration charge is applicable for phone credit card payments.
- If you have no access to the internet or no credit/debit card the school office does have some blank envelopes for cash payments.

- All late orders placed with MSP Photography (after photo day) will incur a minimum \$20 late fee (per order).

Approaching Your School - A parent and community guide for effective communication.

From time to time, parents or other members of the school community may need to approach the school in order to:

- · Discuss the progress or welfare of own child.
- · Express concern about actions of other students.
- · Enquire about school policy or practice.
- · Provide positive feedback regarding a school program, policy or staff member.

It is therefore necessary to have procedures in place that will enable communication to occur in a relaxed and confidential setting. This will assist to ensure that a safe and harmonious school environment is maintained. The best results usually occur from working together. On occasions, concerns may cause frustration and anxiety. At such times, it is always important to organise a time to talk with school staff in an unhurried and confidential atmosphere. Approaching teachers when they are teaching, managing children or engaged in other conversations is inappropriate and often does not result in a positive outcome.

Aims

- · Provide a guide in order that concerns are dealt with in an open and fair manner.
- · Ensure that the rights of students, teachers and parents are respected and upheld.
- Support sensitivity and confidentiality.
- Help reach an agreed solution.
- · Ensure that staff are recognised and praised for their efforts.

Contacting the School

There are several ways to contact the school.

- · Write a note/letter and send to school with your child.
- Contact the school administration office on 4572 3142. If contact is made via phone and you are not able to speak with the appropriate staff member directly, a return call will be made.
- Send the school an email via <u>oakville-p.school@det.nsw.edu.au</u>
- Attend the school administration office in person to arrange a mutually convenient time to meet/speak with the appropriate staff member.

Collecting your child early or bringing your child to school late	 Please always attend the administration office to collect a late arrival slip or early departure slip. 	
The academic progress of own child and/or homework	 Please contact the administration office to arrange a mutually convenient time to meet/speak with your child's teacher. 	



The welfare of own child	 For minor issues contact the administration office to arrange a mutually convenient time to meet/speak with your child's teacher. For more serious concerns, contact administration office. Please state the nature of concern and arrange a suitable time to talk with class teacher and/or Assistant Principal relevant to your child's grade. To convey information about change of address, telephone number, emergency contact, custody details, health issues etc. Please contact the administration office.
Actions of other students	 Classroom Concern: Please contact the administration office to arrange a mutually convenient time to meet/speak with your child's teacher. Playground Concern: Please contact the administration office to arrange a mutually convenient time to meet/speak with your child's teacher or relevant Assistant Principal. Please do not discuss your concern with other parents in person or via social media, as this can often complicate the situation. At no time should a parent approach another child to address an issue at school.
School policy or practice	 Contact the administration office. Please state nature of concern and make a suitable time to speak with the relevant staff member.
Provide positive feedback regarding a school program, policy or staff member.	Contact the administration office to ensure that the relevant staff member receives the information.
